world with creative details.

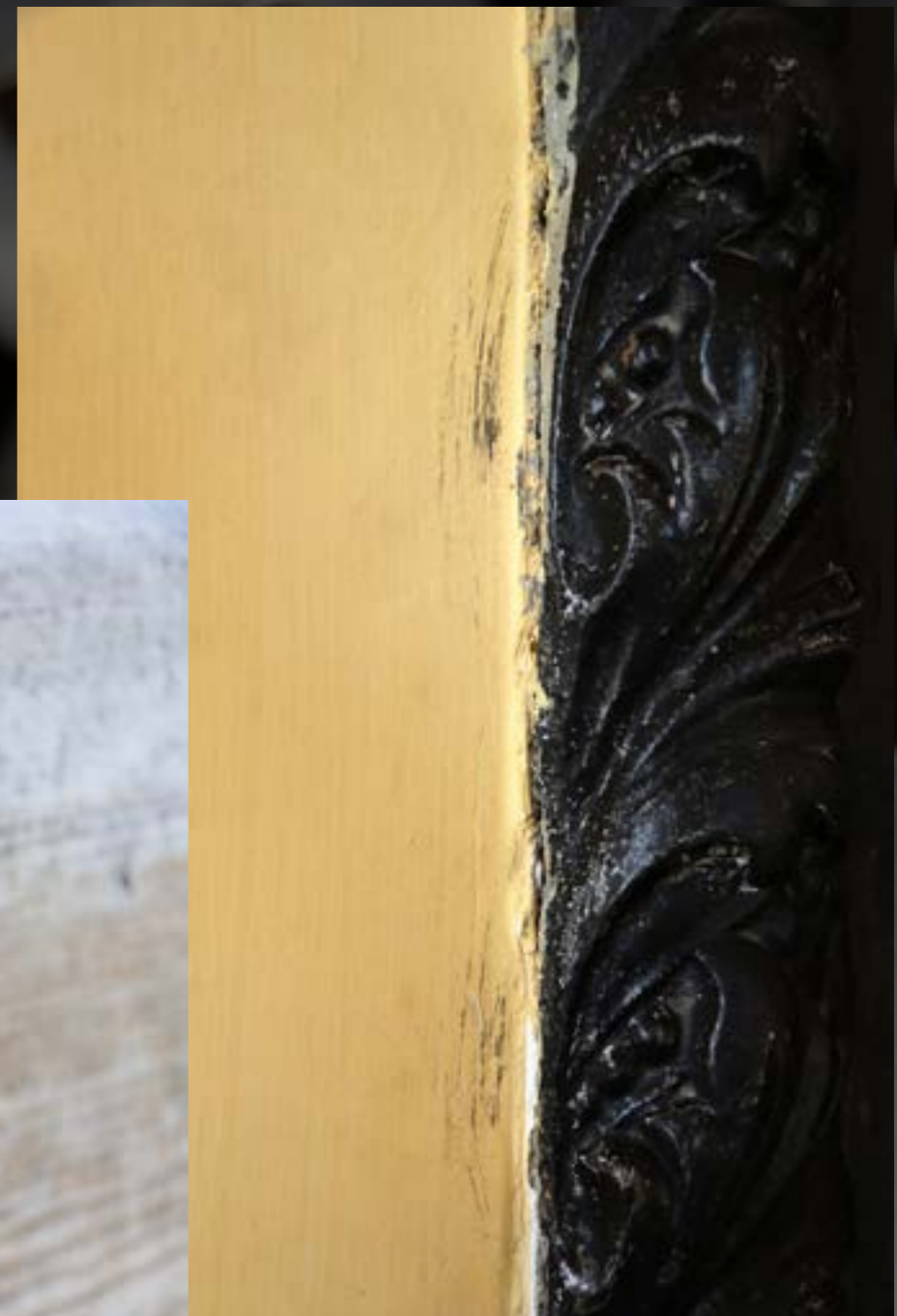






Handiwork

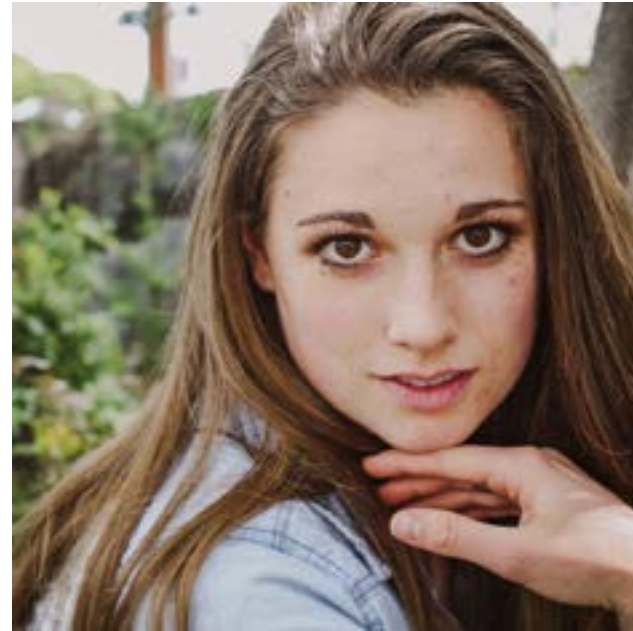
